OUT AND ABOUT

Joffrid Mackett (C82) was in action in the Sri Chinmoy Road 100, held in Commonwealth Park in Canberra on Saturday 24th February. This was a new event on the Australian calendar and had been granted the status of the 2024

Australian 100km Championship. Joff was walking (of course) but rather unprepared, given the short notice for the event. He reached the 50km mark in a time of 7:12:17 before calling it quits. Well done mate!

Pramesh Prasad (C81) was in action in the recent World Cross Country Championships in Belgrade, Serbia. Running for his native Fiji, Pramesh was the second of his team to finish, with all the Fijians completing the 10km course in the cold early Serbian spring. He also competed in the previous World Cross Country Championships in Bathurst so it was a further Fijian vest for him.



24 HEURES DE BOURGES, BOURGES, FRANCE, 24-25 FEBRUARY 2024

Emmanuel Tardi was in the French city of Bourges in late February for the first French 24 Hour Walk of the year and it proved to be an historic occasion when, for the first time in French Athletics Federation history, a woman won an overall title beating all the men who competed! And to cap it off, another women finished second.

The race got underway at 1PM on the Saturday, with 38 walkers contesting the French National 24 Hour Racewalking Championship. The usual 2.5km course had been changed for a shorter loop of 1km. **Peter Van Hove** led out early, followed by **Florian Letourneau, Maxime Laneau** and **Alexandre Forestieri,** with **Morgane Ausello**, the first of the women, one lap behind. Letourneau retired at the 50km mark and then Van Hove retired, leaving Laneau and Forestieri as joint leaders walking together. Ausello was at this stage back in third place, some 10 minutes behind but gradually bridging the gap. In the 113th lap, the incredible arrived as she caught them and took the lead, a lead she then held till the end. Forestieri and Laneau slowed down in the last 4 hours and were caught by **Veronique Bessot**, the second woman.

The final results showed Ausello first with 187.402km, Bessot second with 183.213km and Laneau, the leading male, third with 182.002km.

The 2x6 Hour walks were won by **Alain Malfondet** (52km on the Saturday and 48km on the Sunday) and **Chloé Raes-Maure** (50km and 46km) while there were 10km, 5km and 3km walks for those who wanted shorter options.

24 HEURES DE CHATEAU-THIERRY, CHATEAU-THIERRY, FRA, 30-31 MARCH 2024

Fast forward 5 weeks to the next French 24H Carnival, held on the last weekend of March in the French city of Chateau-Thierry, 100km east of Paris. It was the 47th edition of this iconic event and included the French 100km walk championships. The start time was set for 1PM on the Saturday, with an initial lap of 2.502km, followed by laps of 2.378km. This ensured an exact number of laps for the 100km distance. For the final hour of the 24H race, the lap distance was reduced to 400m.

The lead changed multiple times in the first 3 hours, compliments of **Alexandre Forestieri, Maxime Laneau, Laura De Bontin** and **Morgane Ausello**. At that point, **Florian Letourneau** took over in the front, followed by Ausello. Letourneau was untroubled from then on, taking the 100km championship in a good 11:17:16 and going on to win the 24H walk with a distance of 188.669km. Ausello slowed after the 70km mark but still held her second place overall to the 100km mark, which she reached in 11:41:07, thus winning the women's title. She then retired, job done, and it was left to **Veronique Bessot** to take the 24H title with a distance of 181.074km.

The 2x6Hour walk was won by **Dominique Delange** (52km on the Saturday and 46km on the Sunday, while the individual 6H walks were won by **Jeanick Landormy** and **Marcel Jacob**.
